Young Australian **Soprano, Allegra Giagu** has sung as a soloist with the Australian Chamber Orchestra (ACO), the Melbourne and Sydney Symphony Orchestras, the Australian Opera and Ballet Orchestra, the City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra and the London Philharmonic, Royal Philharmonic, and Philharmonia Orchestras.



Allegra sang at the Opening Ceremony of the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games, on the soundtrack of Baz Luhrmann's Moulin Rouge. She was acclaimed for her performances as soloist for the Edinburgh Military Tattoo – Salute to Australia.

Organist, Jonathan Hope has performed in venues across Britain, Europe and the USA with recent recitals in Canterbury and Southwark Cathedrals. Jonathan will take up the post of Organ Scholar of Southwark Cathedral, London in September this year, conducting the cathedral's 4 choirs and playing the T. C. Lewis organ, one of the highest acclaimed instruments in the UK.
